Most surgeries will be performed with a surgical laser, with the benefits of less pain, less bleeding, less swelling, less risk of infection and quicker recovery. Dr Wolgamott feels this is the way for us to give your pet the best possible care. General anesthesia for surgical and selected diagnostic procedures in pets and involves the administration of anesthesia to induce unconsciousness. Risks associated with anesthesia are greatly reduced through the use of comprehensive anesthetic protocols. The protocols include

The use of the safest anesthetic drugs and gases available.

The use of blood oxygen saturation and heart monitors during surgery.

Direct veterinary supervision of all pets receiving anesthesia.

There are other measures which also may be used to further limit the risks of anesthesia. Please select the following optional services below which you would like for us to use in addition to the standard protocol.

___1. Doctor's Discretion: For those clients who wish to defer to the veterinarians' judgement concerning optional pre-surgical procedures with the understanding that these options necessitate additional charges in addition to surgery fees.

___2. Feline Leukemia/Feline immunodeficiency Virus Test \$39. The stress of surgery can sometimes cause an animal to break with these viruses.

___3. Heartworm/Tick Titer Test \$31. Recommended if your dog has been exposed to ticks or has been off heartworm medication more than 6 months.

___4. Intravenous Fluids Administration During Surgery \$27. Placing an intravenous catheter allows for immediate administration of drugs in an anesthetic emergency, helps improve poor organ functions due to low blood pressure which may occur during surgery and is especially important for older and sick patients but is available to every patient.

___5. Teeth Cleaning \$70 Recommended as a means of providing adequate dental care for your pet.

___6. Microchip \$48.75 for implantation. We insert a small chip, which will provide permanent, 24 hour identification in dogs and cats. Also covers online registration fee.

___7. Pain Medication \$25 Pre and postoperative pain management medication for the comfort and quicker recovery time of the pet. Pain medication before surgery and take home medication.

___8. Basic Procedures For those clients who wish to have only the basic surgery procedures and fees. This may include some vaccinations.

___9 Pre-Anesthetic Blood Testing The most important part of you pets' pre-surgical workup. These tests identify preexisting health problems, which may determine various anesthetic procedures.
